Congratulations to the children who received certificates for their creative projects and to those who achieved a St. Gregory's award at the end of term – keep up your positive attitude!

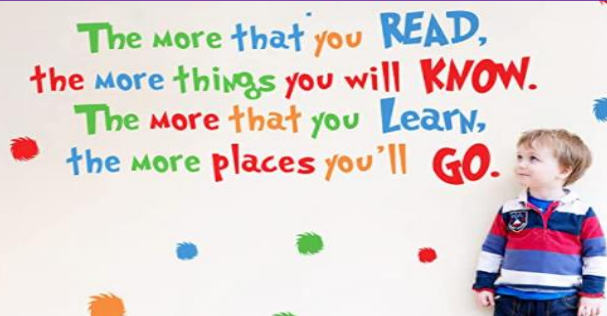
